The proposed Country Club Commons Connector Trail provides a useful street-to-street pedestrian and bicycle connection. We commend the use of boardwalk instead of asphalt and concrete, providing a lighter touch in this wooded habitat.

We recommend that the connector be rerouted to pass through the existing public infrastructure of the fire station parking area. This would save funds initially and in future maintenance costs while also reducing the area of irreplaceable natural habitat to be sacrificed.

In general we encourage all proposed bicycle transportation paths to avoid sacrificing wooded areas wherever possible, but rather make use of existing maintained paved surfaces, weaving the hundreds of miles of quiet residential streets in the City into a network akin to the vision of the [Mason To Metro Bicycle Route](#) or [The Spine](#) .
